

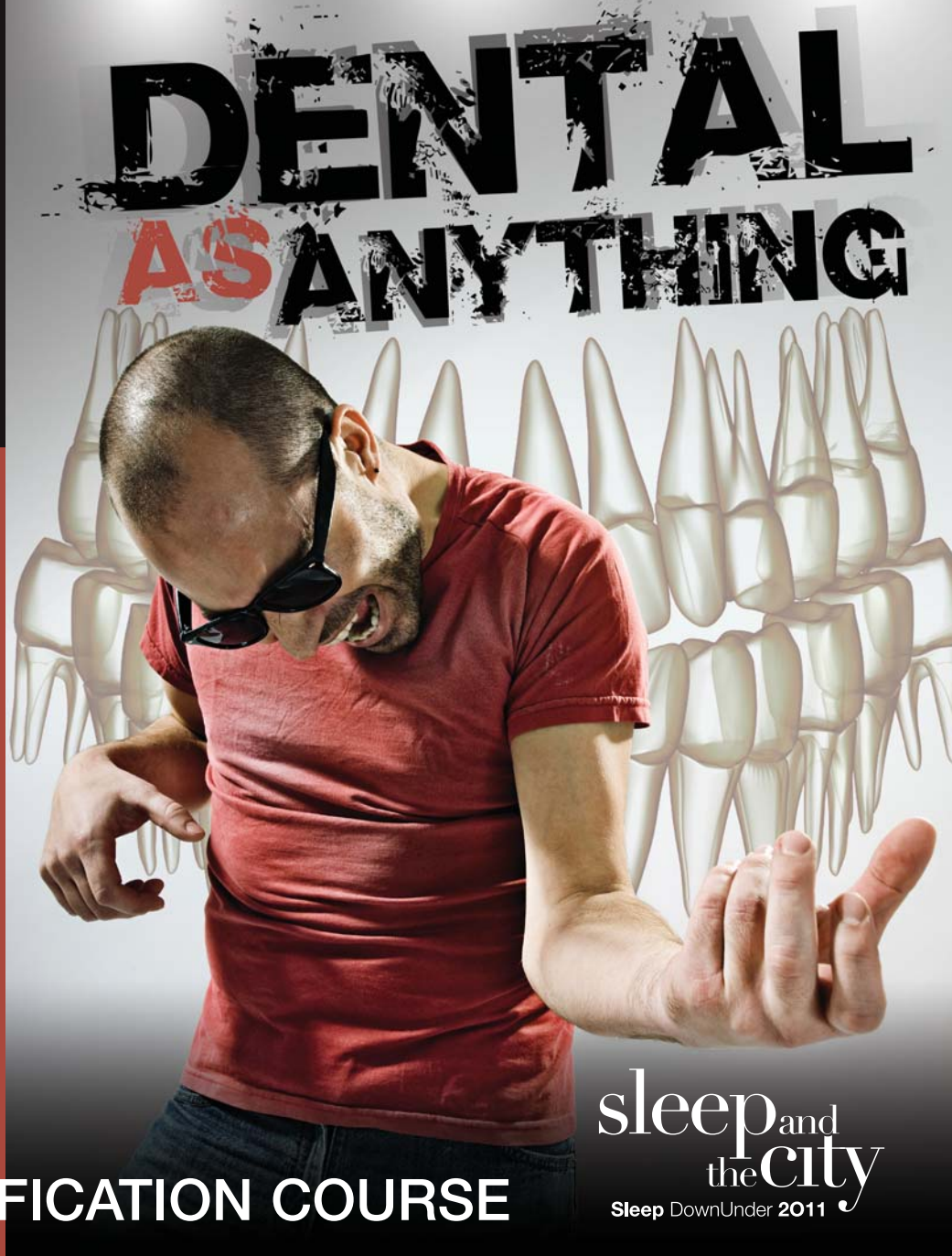
# Oral Sleep Medicine Course 2011

The 3-day course is intended for dental professionals new to sleep disorders dentistry or those currently treating snoring and obstructive sleep apnoea (OSA) patients using oral appliances. The course emphasises the multidisciplinary approach to sleep disorders dentistry with comprehensive presentations as listed in the programme below. The international panel of presenters includes: dentists, oromaxillofacial surgeons, orthodontists, ENT surgeons and sleep physicians, all of whom are highly experienced in practising in the field of oral sleep medicine.

Participating clinicians will gain a working knowledge and the confidence to offer oral appliance therapy to patients with sleep-disordered breathing. The course is designed to cover the pre-requisite topics

to give dentists an acceptable level of education, training and experience in this growing area of practice.

This course, the fourth of such programmes sponsored by the ASA, was initiated to set standards for the scope of dental practice in sleep medicine. As this is now encouraged by Dental Boards in Australia and New Zealand, participants will receive a certificate accrediting a CPD course in Oral Sleep Medicine.

Our guest international presenter, Dr Jonathan Parker, is a dentist with over 20 years experience in treating sleep disordered breathing. Since 2001 his practice has been limited to the management of snoring and OSA. As a pioneer and leader in dental sleep medicine, Dr. Parker is well known in both USA and throughout the world as a

course provider on the dentists' role in the treatment of sleep disorders. Dr. Parker is also a consultant to a number of sleep disorders centers in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area. Besides being a stimulating and entertaining lecturer, he has authored a number of research articles and abstracts evaluating the effectiveness of oral appliances for sleep-disordered breathing.
